

Ballot to Select the Title I Parent Committee Structure

Title I schools are required to include parents in the decision-making process regarding the Title I educational program. As discussed during the Title I parent meeting, Title I parents (*all parents in a Title I Schoolwide Program school and eligible parents in a Title I Targeted Assistance school*) may choose to form one of the following for representation:

- a parent subcommittee of the existing Parent Association (PA)/Parent-Teacher Association (PTA) or;
- a Title I Parent Advisory Council (PAC).

These Title I parent representatives will be working closely with our School Leadership Team to provide input and feedback regarding the school's Comprehensive Educational Plan (CEP), Title I parent involvement policy and school-parent compact, as well as collaboratively deciding on the use of the Title I parent involvement monies.
